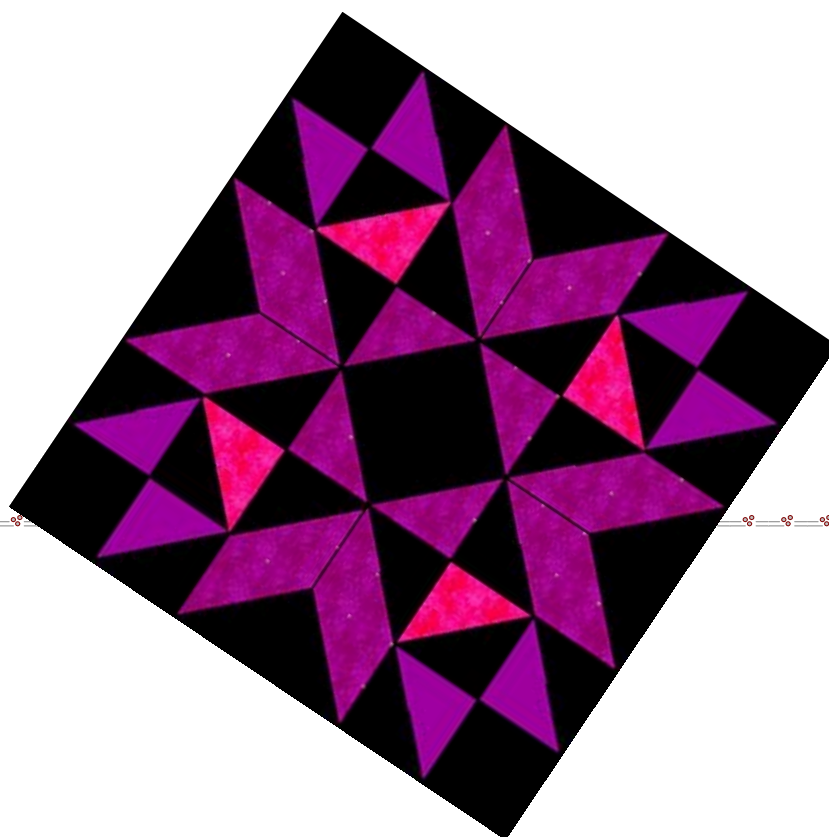

Fuchsia Scraps  
**Black** - 1/4 yard



### Supplies:

Black color cotton thread  
Template plastic for templates  
Scissors  
Basic sewing supplies

### Cutting the patches required:

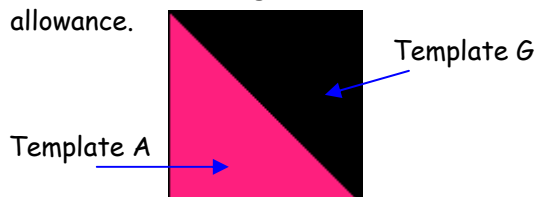
Methods given:

Templates: Transfer the patterns to template plastic and use to cut fabric patches required.

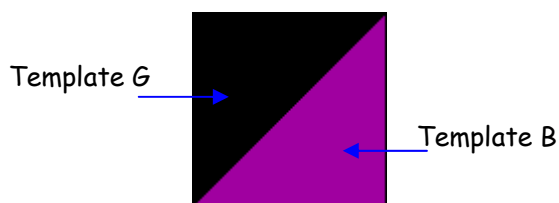


### Piecing Instructions for the Modern Madness Block

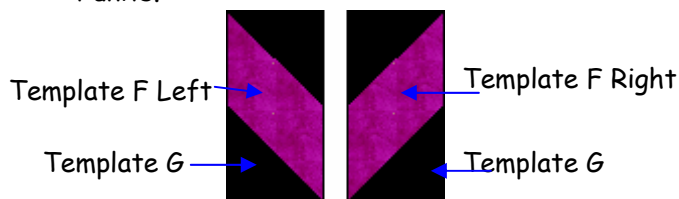
1. Unit 1: Make 4, using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance.



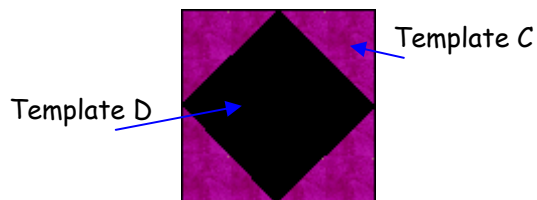
2. Unit 2: Make 8, using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance.



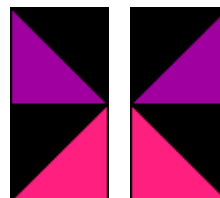
3. Units 3 & 4 : Make 4 of each, using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance. Then sew together to make 4 units.



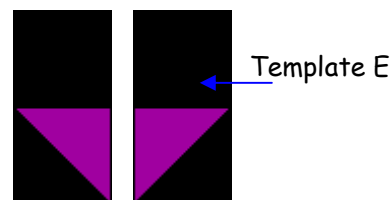
4. Unit 5 : Make 1 for the center of the block, using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam allowance.



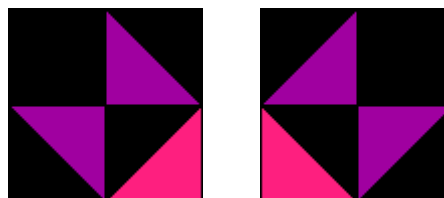
5. Using units 1 & 2: Make 4 combined units, 2 in each direction.



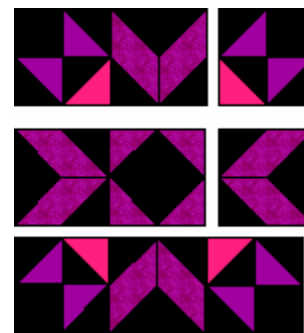
6. Using units 2 & Template E: Make 4 combined units, 2 in each direction.



7. Using units made in steps 5 & 6: Make 4 combined units, 2 in each direction.



8. Sew the units together as shown to complete the block.

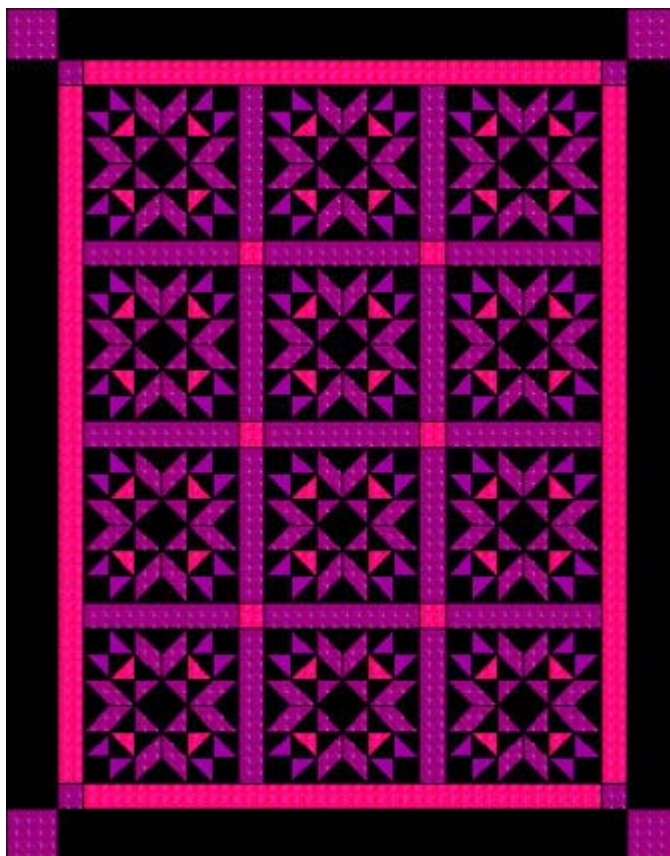
## Alternate Quilt

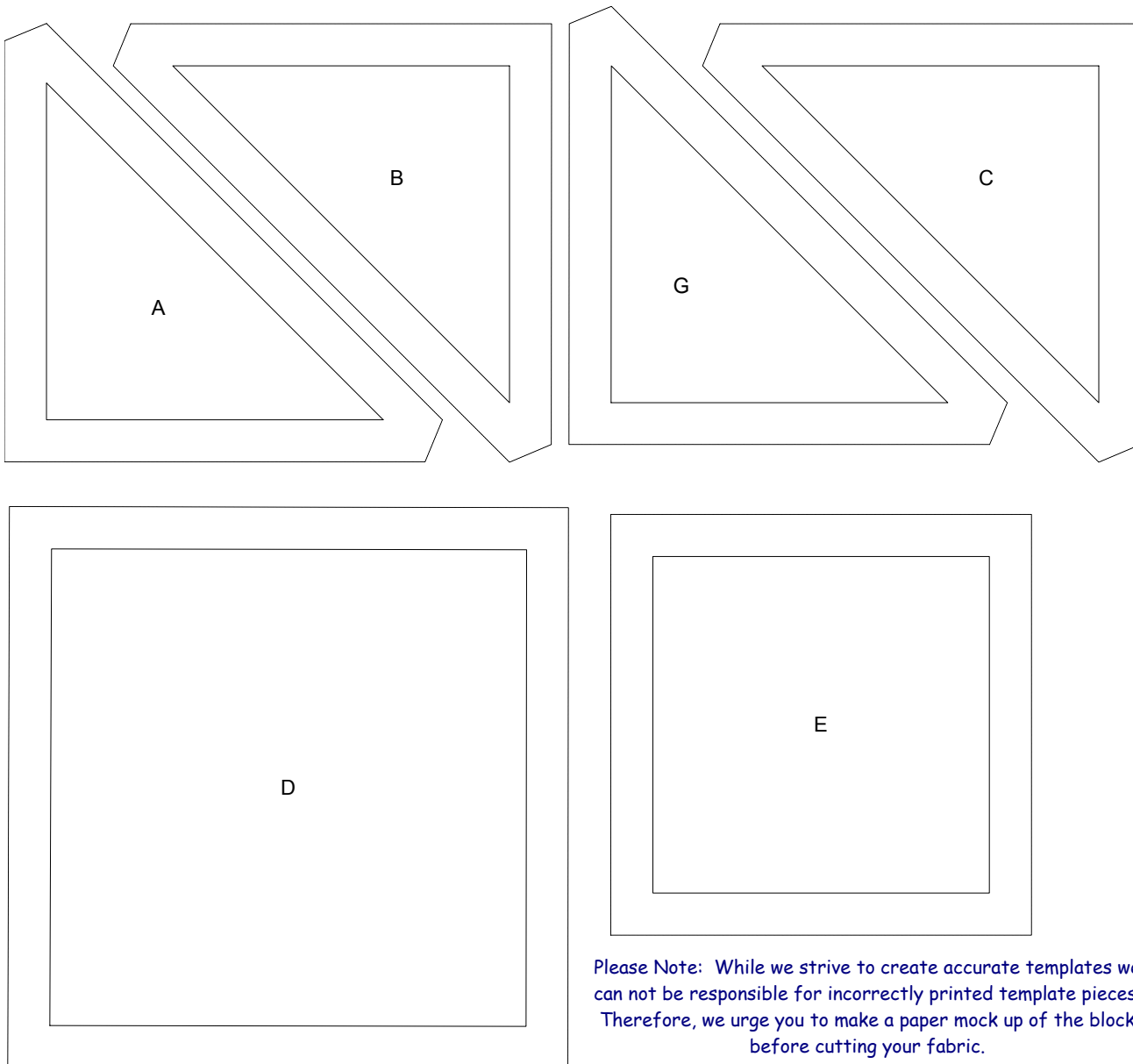

- Cut 4 - A - Fushica
- Cut 8 - B - Med Purple
- Cut 4 - C - Dark Purple
- Cut 1 - D - Black
- Cut 4 - E - Black
- Cut 4 - F Left - Dark Purple
- Cut 4 - F Right - Dark Purple
- Cut 28 G - Black

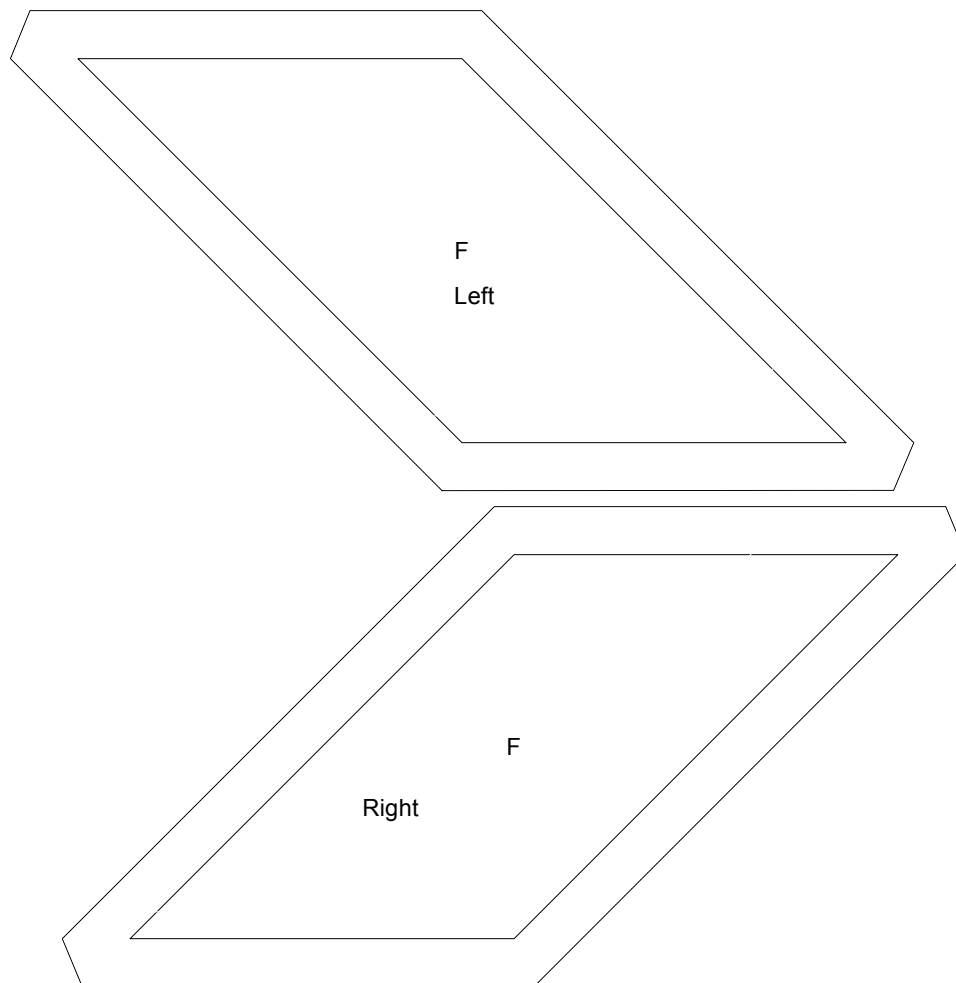
